5 Steps to Sign up for a Tournament

1. To sign up for USTA tournaments, a USTA membership is required. You can sign up for a membership at USTA.com.
2. Know which level you should participate in. See below for more detail on levels
3. Go to tennislink.usta.com/tournaments and search for the *Find a Tournament* section.
4. If you know the tournament name, enter it, but if you want to browse for a tournament click on *Tournaments Advanced Search*.
5. Once you find the tournament you want to play, go ahead and register before the close of registrations.

- ◆ L8—Futures—Participation points only (Novice)
- ◆ L7—Entry Level Events (Novice/Intermediate)
- ◆ L6—Other State Championships (Intermediate)
- ◆ L5—Designated State Championships (Advance)
- ◆ L4—USTA/MAS Challengers (Advance, Ranking required)
- ◆ L4+ - USTA/MAS Championship 660 (Advance, Ranking required)
- ◆ L3—USTA/MAS Championship 700 (Advance, Ranking required)
- ◆ L2—Level 2 National Events (Advance, High ranking required)
- ◆ L1—Level 1 National Events (Advance, High ranking required)
